SUBJECT	COLORS and SCRIPTURE
Bride of Messiah	White, silver, iridescence, silver: We are purified when Yeshua redeemed us so that we may become holy as He is holy (Malachi 3:3; Deuteronomy 22:29; Ephesians 4:24). Add in a Light Pink for the healing of the wounds of the bride.
Covenant (see also Rainbow)	Red, yellow, blue, orange, green and purple: (Genesis 9:13)
Divine Revelation	Sapphire, blue and gold: (Exodus 24:10)
Faith	Yellow, green and blue: Faith in God's ways given to us by the Holy Spirit brings life to us now and for eternity (Romans 4:20; Hebrews 10:15-16; 1 John 2:25)
Fire of God	Gold, Red & Silver: the Consuming Fire of God; Sacrifice of Prayer (Hebrews 13:15) Praise and worship (Chronicles 23:13) Revival fire, Refiner's fire (1 Corinthians 3:13) the passion of Yeshua for His Bride and the bride's response to Yeshua. Also Yellow, Orange and Red: As we stand in faith and the glory of God is revealed, no enemy can penetrate His protection or overcome His deliverance (Romans 4:20; Psalm 97:3; Joshua 2:18-21)
Grace	Purple and pink: We are adopted into royalty when we are birthed into God's Kingdom. This is only done by His grace He provides everything we need. (2 Corinthians 8:9)
Healing/Faithfulness	Light Pink and Silver: (Acts 9:34)
Healing Waters	Blue and Aqua: Life cleansing healing (Psalm 1:1-3; Revelation 22:1)
His Glory	Yellow and gold: (John 1:14)
His Precious Blood	Red and gold (also Red alone): (1 Peter 1:19)
Holy Fire, Baptism in the Holy Spirit	Wine, orange, red, yellow and white: (Acts 2:3-4)
Holy Spirit / Shekinah	Light Blue and clear/iridescent: (1 John 2:20)
Intercession	White, silver and gold
Israel	Silver and blue
Majesty	Purples, blues, red and gold: Dignity, priestly, power, authority, ruler, King or high official (1 Chronicles 29:24-25; 2 Chronicles 2:14; 3:14; Jeremiah 10:9; Esther 8:15; Ezekiel 27:7)
Mercy	Purple and red: Yeshua is our mediator and redeemer, He clothed us in salvation and gives us a robe of righteousness (Titus 3:4-7; Isaiah 61:10)
Praise	Fuchsia, purple and aqua: We have joy in the wealth of the Holy Spirit (Jeremiah 33:9; Hebrews 2:10-12; 13:15) Also the colors of Orange, gold, silver, red and yellow: denotes ecstatic, vibrant praise.
Rainbow/ Glory of God/ Covenant Promise	Red, yellow, orange, purple, blue, green and gold: God's promises (Revelation 4:3) Covenant promise (Genesis 9:13, 16; Ezekiel 1:28).
Repentance/ The Priesthood of Believers	Black, red and white: All can be redeemed by Yeshua through repentance, because all of us fall short of God's glory (Romans 3:23-24) These are the colors of Levi, the Tribe of the priesthood. Since we have become a kingdom of priests through the shed blood of Yeshua, we need always to live a life of repentance unto our God to have complete and lasting shalom in our hearts (The Book to the Hebrews; Revelation 1:6; 5:10).
Righteousness	White: Matthew 13:14
River of God	Blue, aqua and silver:
Royalty	Purple and red:
Royalty of Messiah/ Also the Priesthood of Believers	Plum, grape, purple, orchid and white: (Revelation 1:6)
Tabernacle	Gold, bronze, purple, white, scarlet, blue and silver: the colors used in the Tabernacle in the Wilderness where God dwelled with the Israelites (Exodus 25:1-8; 28:5-12; 36:8; 39:1)
Warfare	Orange, Gold and Red: (the fire colors)
Worship	Purple, blue, and wine: Longing, seeking to be in His presence (Matthew 2:2; John 9:31)
